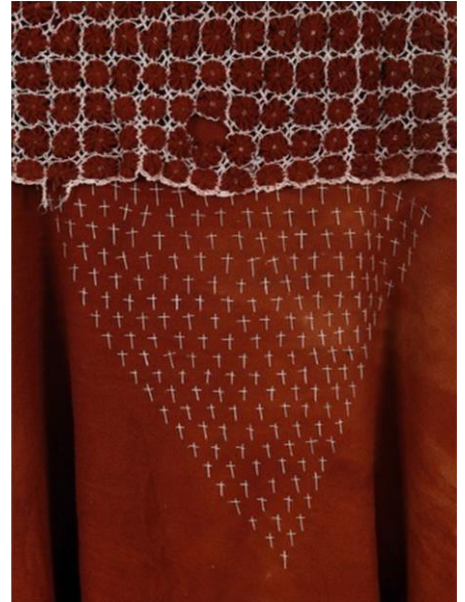


Glenys Mann
